OVERVIEW

Staff from the Ohio Department of Medicaid will conduct this training, which will provide an overview of OhioRISE, a new program serving children and youth ages 0 – 20 with complex behavioral health and multisystem needs. Attendees will understand how eligibility and enrollment into OhioRISE using the new Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths, or CANS, assessment tool and how enrollment due to inpatient psychiatric hospital admissions work.

Participants will learn how the new and enhanced services and supports, and billing and coding information may be used by hospitals to expand access to care. As hospitals are part of the full continuum of care and a key community partner, this training will inform hospitals on the new care management entities in their regions and what their roles and responsibilities are to support care coordination across multiple systems for children, youth and families.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Become aware of OhioRISE and key components of the program including eligibility, services and supports, and the new CANS assessment tool.
- Understand the OhioRISE Mixed Services Protocol and general coding for the new OhioRISE services.
- Learn about the new care management entities, their role to coordinate care and how they can work with hospital systems
