PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES

OSHFHM was established as an affiliated society of OHA in 1983. The society's purpose is to advance the development of hospital engineering in Ohio by:

- Encouraging and assisting members in developing their knowledge and increasing their competence in the field in order to improve the quality of patient care and comfort.
- Providing a medium for the exchange of ideas and dissemination of information among members.
- Assisting hospital administration and the public in understanding that the practice of hospital engineering calls for special training and experience.
- Monitoring and influencing legislation, regulations, codes and standards that impact on hospital engineering.

In meeting these objectives, the Ohio Society for Hospital Engineering promotes careers in hospital engineering, develops educational programming, and encourages affiliation with the American Society for Hospital Engineering.

MEMBERSHIP

Members shall include management, staff, professionals, and representatives of OHA member hospitals and OHA corporate partners who are actively employed in, by or on behalf of a hospital or health system, and who have responsibility regarding healthcare facilities management, plant engineering, design/construction, security, safety, clinical engineering, and-or tele-communications. All candidates for membership must be eligible for personal membership in OHA.

LEADERSHIP

The OSHFM board of directors comprises 14 members including the president, president-elect, immediate past president, secretary, two members from each of the four OHA districts and two at-large representatives.

Responsibilities of the board include developing plans, policies and procedures for the society; establishing standing and ad hoc committees; reviewing the recommendations of these committees; implementing society programs; and initiating educational programming.
