

# **Ohio Society Healthcare Human Resources Administrators (OSHHRA)**

## **SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

### **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

The Ohio Society Healthcare Human Resources Administrators (OSHHRA) recognizes the need for future well-trained Human Resources Professionals. As a result, the Society will provide an annual scholarship to assist an individual who is enrolled in a Human Resources Program at an accredited university.

### **PURPOSE**

To ensure the Society assists healthcare organizations meet future recruitment and retention objectives.

### **PROCEDURE**

- I. Scholarships will be awarded according to the following guidelines:
  - A. Applicants who are currently enrolled in a Human Resources Program at an accredited university may be eligible for the OSHHRA Scholarship Program.
  - B. The applicant must be in the last year of education at the university to be eligible for the scholarship.
  - C. The applicant must submit their application along with two (2) reference letters to the Scholarship Committee to be considered for the scholarship.
  - D. The applicant's submitted scholarship application and recommendation/reference letters will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee to determine if the scholarship is warranted.
  - E. Failure to comply with all aspects of the Scholarship Program will result in applicant being ineligible for consideration for the scholarship.
- II. Two scholarships will be available annually, one in the Spring and one in the Fall. The Scholarship Program is subject to change and scholarships will be awarded based on the Society's current financial status and ability to support the Program.
