IMPROVING HAND HYGIENE RATES

OHA's hand hygiene program focuses on improving hand hygiene rates by assessing hospital staff compliance by directly observing hospital caregivers as they enter and exit patient rooms. OHA will provide recommendations on how hospitals can improve their rates by redesigning policies and offering more robust education and training opportunities. Participating hospitals set a goal of reaching 100% compliance.

COMPARE COMPLIANCE RATES WITH PARTICIPATING HOSPITALS

MOHA's observers enter data in real time using a hand-held device and an app developed by OHA specifically for the quality improvement initiative.

The data is quickly aggregated for members to use the same day and/or

monthly.

Clinical leaders of participating hospitals meet regularly with OHA's team to

review compliance data and share best practices on how to achieve and sustain high compliance rates.
